Erasmus, however, differed from the general opinion in finding that of 11 cases only 2 were primarily synovial. As to the individual bones affected, Czerny found that in 52 cases the astragalus was affected 15 times, the os calcis 13 times, the cuboid 16 times, and the scaphoid and cuneiform 8 times. Often the lower end of the tibia is affected while there is a focus in the head of the astragalus, but the complex arrangement of the synovial membrane at the ankle makes extension of the disease very easy to other bones and other parts of the articulation from that originally affected, and the same condition renders complete removal of the diseased tissues very difficult. The symptoms of disease of the anklejoint, in addition to the swelling, have been very slightly alluded...
